

INFORMATION CLAUSE

In connection with art. 13 (1) and (2) and Article 14 para. 5 point b) of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals in connection with the processing of personal data and on the free flow of such data and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Regulation device data protection).

1. Video monitoring is carried out by Stara Zajezdnia Kraków by DeSilva, to ensure the safety of persons staying in the monitored area (including the safety of employees) and the protection of property, fire protection and anti-flood protection.
2. Video monitoring includes: courtyard, a small restaurant, a beer hall, mezzanine of a beer hall, a fire escape road, an emergency exit, a brewhouse.

6. The recipient of your personal data will be only entities authorized under the law.
7. Processing is necessary to fulfill the legal obligation of the Administrator - art. 6 sec. 1 lit. c GDPR.
8. The monitoring records will be stored until the overwriting (depending on the size of the recordings) up to 40 days or until the final conclusion of the proceedings conducted under the law.
9. You have the right to access the recordings in justified cases and the right to process data for a limited time.
10. A person registered by the monitoring system has the right to the content of data on the principles specified in art. 15 of the GDPR, the right to limit the processing of data on the principles set out in art. 18 GDPR.
11. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body - the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection (to the address of the Office for Personal Data Protection, 2 Stawki Street, 00-193 Warsaw), when you consider that processing of personal data concerning you is in breach of the general provisions of the Data Protection Regulation.
